X	Plowing is to be done at both locations. Station #1 property consists of areas along the front of Lake View Road including the front of fire apparatus bays. Area along the side of Burke Road including large parking area in the rear of the firehall including the "Pass Thru Lane" (must be kept cleared), the area directly adjacent to the south of the fire hall consisting of all parking areas in the area designated as "fire association" and accessed off Lake View Road. Station #2 property consists of area along Route 5 (Lake Shore Road) including the front fire apparatus bays. All parking area to the east of the building and the vehicle access area to the rear of the fire station including the "Mechanic's Bay Lane" (must be kept clear). <u>Add as a separate bid for clearing the auxiliary parking lot on Burke Road opposite the main parking area. This area should not be included in the bid for Stations 1 &amp; 2 and will be plowed only after consultation and approval of the Fire Commissioner Project Manager award.</u>
X	Snow is to be plowed from all paved surfaces that are designed for motor vehicle traffic and parking areas. The bidder will erect and maintain proper staking of the properties (with the exception of the auxiliary parking area)
X	Snow shall be plowed when it reaches a depth of three inches, whether from snow fall accumulation, blowing and drifting, or both. This includes in front of the hay doors to prevent an ice "hump" from forming. Snow is to be plowed to pavement level whenever possible, (NO "SHOES" ON PLOW).
X	Snow should not be piled so that it obstructs the view of a motor vehicle operator from entering, leaving, or operating on public roadways. No snow at Station #2 is to be pushed across Fairway Dr.
X	Driveways and parking areas must be kept clear of snow that accumulates from municipal snow removal activities, i.e. State, County, and Town plows and equipment.
X	Any work that is deemed necessary such as snow removal or piling, above and beyond the plowing contract, must be approved by at least two fire commissioners prior to work being performed. The contractor will not be compensated for any additional work that is performed without approval.
X	A fire district contact will be designated for all questions or concerns after the contract is awarded.
X	Contractor will provide the Lake View Fire District with an owner's protective liability insurance policy before commencing any work on Lake View's premises.
X	See below for hold harmless provisions
X	Contractor will install and remove snow fence barrier (approximately 175' in length and supplied by the fire district) at Fire Station #2 on land 35' off and adjacent the parking lot (prior approval has been provided by the Frontier Central School District) based on approved snow fencing specifications (separate attachment). Installation will be no later than November 10,2020 and removed no earlier than March 15, 2021.

**Contract proposal should be submitted based on cost per month for the period November 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021 and cost per plowing per time for periods beyond March 31, 2021, if needed.**

To the fullest extent permitted by law the Contractor will indemnify and hold harmless the Lake View Fire District and its employees, elected and appointed officials and authorized volunteers from and against claims, tangible property (other than the work itself), but only to the extent caused by the negligent acts or omissions of the Contractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by it or anyone for whose acts the Contractor may be liable regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or otherwise reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to a party or person described herein.

In claims against any person or entity indemnified herein by an employee of the Contractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by them, or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, the indemnification obligation herein shall not be limited by a limitation on the amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the Contractor under worker's compensation acts, disability benefit acts or other employee benefit including relevant sections of the New York State Labor Law,

Indemnity under this agreement shall commence when the Contractor begins his work and shall continue in full force until the expiration of the statutory period for filing claims,

Lake View Fire District agrees to notify Contractor in writing within ten (10) days by certified mail at Contractor's address as stated in this agreement of any claim made against the Lake View Fire District for which indemnification is provided.
